

Overview of the NZ Super Fund

- The <u>NZ Super Fund</u> invests money on behalf of the New Zealand Government to help pay for the increased cost of universal pension entitlements in the future.
- By doing this the Fund adds to Crown wealth, improves the ability of future Governments to pay for universal pensions, and ultimately reduces the tax burden on future New Zealanders.
- A long-term, growth-oriented investor, the Fund has around NZ\$60 billion in assets. The Fund is managed by a Crown entity, the Guardians of New Zealand Superannuation.

Our function

Our endowments

There are four "endowments" that stem from the way the NZ Super Fund has been set up, which shape and guide our investment decisions.



LONG HORIZON

We have the ability to invest in illiquid assets and ride out short-term market movements



OPERATIONAL INDEPENDENCE

Investments by the NZ Super Fund are made on a purely commercial basis



SOVEREIGN STATUS

Our sovereign status allows us to pay lower tax in some jurisdictions and is often favourably regarded by business partners




GOVERNANCE

The Guardians is designed to operate at arms' length from the Government



Our Reference Portfolio

The Reference Portfolio benchmarks the performance of our Actual Portfolio and the value we are adding through active investment strategies.



The Reference Portfolio, which is capable of meeting the Fund's objectives over time, is a shadow or notional portfolio of passive, low-cost, listed investments suited to the NZ Super Fund's long-term investment horizon and risk profile

The Reference Portfolio is therefore a very clear and 'pure' way for us to:


- 1. Estimate the NZ Super Fund's expected returns;
- Benchmark active (value add) investment returns net of all costs; and
- 3. Be clear on the 'hurdles' for active investments

The Reference Portfolio is set by our Board and is reviewed every 5 years (the last review was in 2020)



The Reference Portfolio vs Actual Portfolio


Both portfolios are growth-oriented and highly diversified. The Actual Portfolio includes active investments that are expected to add value with an acceptable level of risk.




Cumulative contributions and size of NZ Super Fund






